- All carriers transporting eggs must be clean. All footwear must be clean, and free from faecal
 contamination, feathers, or other bedding matter.
- All participants must present a signed declaration confirming the origin of the poultry is not from
 within a restricted area, the identified birds are healthy, and they will follow the instructions of
 the poultry gathering licence

Show Terms & Conditions

- No exhibits shall be attended to during judging.
- No exhibitor shall approach the judges prior to or during judging. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.
