Show Terms & Conditions

Members who wish to exhibit at competition shows are to abide by the following terms and conditions laid down by the committee and under the rules of the Poultry Club of Great Britain.

- 1) All birds must be in a fit and healthy condition. Birds, which are not in a fit and healthy condition, shall be disqualified and removed to a quarantine area away from other member's birds. (Any such action shall be reported at the first opportunity to a full committee to decide if further action should be taken against the exhibitor).
- 2) All birds shall be transported to the show in suitable containers.
- 3) No birds or exhibits shall be attended to during judging.
- 4) No exhibitor shall approach the judges prior to or during judging. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.
- 5) No birds or exhibits shall be entered in duplicate classes.
- 6) No telephone entries shall be accepted.
- 7) Late entries and those not accompanied by fees shall not be accepted.
- 8) No leg rings except Birds with official Poultry Club rings (PCGB, EE, Isle of Man, BWA) shall be allowed.
- 9) No person shall leave the show with birds until the show is finished.
- 10) Juveniles entering any classes other than Juvenile shall pay adult entrance fees.
- 11) Classes may be amalgamated or divided into sub-classes at the committees discretion
- 12) All entry forms shall state breed, colour and sex of all exhibits.
- 13) Non-standard colours or breeds may only be exhibited in non-standard classes. (Any non-standard colours shall be disqualified from relevant breed classes.)
- 14) Best of Class Rosettes shall be awarded to all Juvenile class winners, adult bird classes with 4 or more exhibits, & in adult egg classes with 7 or more exhibits
- 15) Whilst taking reasonable care, the club cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage to birds, exhibits or equipment
- 16) Any breach of these terms and conditions shall be reported at the first opportunity to a full committee to decide if further action should be taken
- 17) The decision of the committee shall be final and binding.

Please Note:

1. One free admission ticket to the Showground will be given to each entry whose value is £14 or more.
2. If you enter fewer birds than this, you may make your cheque up to £14 (OAP £12, Child £4, child entries will only receive a child entry ticket) in order to qualify for an admission ticket .. eg. 3 birds = £6.00, add £8 to this and qualify for an admission ticket Only 1 free ticket per entry can be given. Joint or family memberships may enter two or more separate entries, each of £14, to qualify for 2 or more free tickets.
3. Please enclose **a stamped addressed envelope** with your entry for return of ticket and car pass.
- 4 Discounted tickets can be purchased prior to the show as follows:
Adults: £14.00, Senior Citizens: £12.00, Child £4.00 (5-15 yrs)
Family: (2 Adults+ 3 children 5-15 years) £35.00

The Tendring Hundred Committee are not allowing movement of vehicles on the Showground between the hours of 9.30 am and 6.00 pm. Gates open from 7.00am.
